



OXFORD ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIREMENTS

To equitably and efficiently select scholarship winners, the following requirements are established:

1. Graduating high school senior
2. Currently residing within the boundaries of Oxford Community Schools
3. Minimum grade point average: 3.2 high school
4. The individual must be genuinely committed to complete the program through education for which the stipend is requested

INFORMATION

1. Deadline of **April 12, 2024** is established to allow thorough review of applications
2. \$1,000 Scholarship (one scholarship will be awarded)

CRITERIA

1. List school activities, years of participation and office held or awards received.
2. Academic honors received – give name and date.
3. List community activities, volunteer service, years of participation and office held or awards received.
4. Names and dates of employment and responsibilities.
5. Write a one page biographical sheet; include why you should be the recipient of this scholarship. Essays will be evaluated on the basis of content, grammar, punctuation, spelling and originality.
6. Essays must be typed or computer generated.
7. Three letters of personal reference dated for 2023-2024. Only one can be from school staff.
