Dear Operator:

I am in receipt of the results of the coliform bacteria water samples, collected at least 24 hours apart, which were reported as "not detected". I am also in receipt of your completed Level One Assessment Form.

You are required to submit **three (3)** additional routine coliform samples in the month of September 2017 before you can resume your normal monitoring frequency. **Statute 325.1007 of Michigan's Safe Drinking Water Act allows this Division to impose a civil fine of \$200 against a public water system that fails to collect the required water samples. Each subsequent violation may result in a \$400 civil fine. We urge you to submit water samples diligently to avoid this type of enforcement action.** *Please consider this letter as notification to collect the required water samples.*
