Oxford HIGH School

Students at Oxford High School are expected to continue learning from April 20 – June 5, 2020 for the completion of semester 2. Students will choose either to take a letter grade or a Pass/Fail grade for each course before Wednesday, June 3rd.

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Haiku is the learning management system for all classes in Oxford Schools. OHS teachers will post a weekly schedule by 9am on Mondays in Haiku.

Teachers will conduct two live or asynchronous lessons a week. These lessons will be delivered either through video conferencing, prerecorded video, online interaction, group/class discussion or other forms of a lesson each week. If the learning activity requires live interaction (i.e. zoom session), teachers must use the class meeting schedule for their building. Lessons should not be more than 30-45 minutes at the high school level.

Online classes - Credit Recovery online classes: There will be no final exam, just 100% course completion. Please contact your student's instructor if you have questions.

Online Class within a student's schedule or 21F: No winter semester final exams for the 2019-2020 school year. If a student completes 80% of the content in a course with a passing grade, the student can opt to take the class for pass/fail If a student wants to receive a letter grade, the student will be held responsible for 100% of the content (except final exams).

Teachers will be assigning and collecting one to two assignments per week. Teachers will be grading and providing feedback on these assignments within five school days.

Teachers will check in every two weeks and will hold office hours (that they will communicate) for both students and parent/guardians.

For each course students will have the option to take the course for a letter grade or Pass/Fail. By June 3rd students will need to inform their teachers if they intend to take the letter grade earned for semester 2. Teachers will indicate a Pass/Fail grade by default if they are not contacted by the student.

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Letter grades will be included in a student's overall GPA. A Pass grade will be indicated by a letter "G" and is not included in a student's GPA. All failing grades whether the student opted for a letter grade or a Pass/Fail grade will impact a student's overall GPA.
