Haiku is the learning management system for all classes in Oxford Schools. OMS teachers will post a weekly schedule by 9am on Mondays in Haiku.

**LIVE ADVISORY on MONDAYS** @ **NOON!** Students have been a part of their Advisory 'family' since the first day of school, and Advisory will continue during remote learning! Students will use the link provided in their Advisory class Haiku page each week to join the Zoom meeting.

Teachers will conduct two live or asynchronous lessons a week. These lessons will be delivered either through video conferencing, prerecorded video, online interaction, group/class discussion or other forms of a lesson each week. If the learning activity requires live interaction (i.e. zoom session), teachers must use the class meeting schedule for their building. Lessons should not be more than 30 minutes at the middle school level.

Live lesson Schedule -

Teachers will be assigning and collecting one to two assignments per week. Teachers will be grading and providing feedback on these assignments within five school days.

Teachers will check in every two weeks and will hold office hours (that they will communicate) for both students and parent/guardians.

For each course students will have the option to take the course for a letter grade or Pass/Fail. By June 3rd students will need to inform their teachers if they intend to take the letter grade earned for semester 2. Teachers will indicate a Pass/Fail grade by default if they are not contacted by the student.

## Important to note:

Letter grades will be included in a student's overall GPA. A Pass grade will be indicated by a letter "G" and is not included in a student's GPA. All failing grades whether the student opted for a letter grade or a Pass/Fail grade will impact a student's overall GPA.
